INVITATION TO THE EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP FOR WAYFARER 2018

ASSENS SEJLKLUB, DENMARK 3RD TO 7TH JULY 2018.

Assens Sejlklub, together with the Scandinavian Wayfarer Association, has the pleasure of inviting you to the European Championship for Wayfarer, from Tuesday, July 3rd to Saturday, July 7th on the waters outside Assens Sejlklub on Fyn in Denmark.

PROGRAMME:

Tuesday:	Arrival, registration and measurement from 10 AM to 8 PM. We expect to arrange practice races from 5 PM to 7:30 PM. Opening ceremony 8 PM.		
Wednesday:	Breakfast 8 AM to 9 AM	I. Start 10 AM	Dinner 6 PM
Thursday:	Breakfast 8 AM to 9 AM	I. Start 10 AM	Dinner 6 PM
Friday:	Breakfast 8 AM to 9 AM	I. Start 10 AM	Dinner 6 PM
Saturday:	Breakfast 8 AM to 9 AM	I. Start 10 AM	Dinner and prize ceremony 7 PM

A total of 11 sailings will be settled over the 4 days.

The participant fee is 1,200 DKK (Approx. 162 Euro) which must be paid to Assens Sailing Club on account Fynske Bank 68500000331399 (IBAN: DK7368500000331399), no later than Sunday, June 3rd. The payment must include name of owner and name and sail number of the relevant boat.

The participant fee does not include breakfast or dinner. Breakfast and self-made lunch cost 100 DKK (approx. 13,5 Euro) per day and dinner costs 200 DKK (approx. 27 Euro) per day. A package for all 4 days costs 1,200 DKK (approx. 162 Euro). If you don't want the total package you can order meals separately.


The payment must include name of owner, name and sail number of the relevant boat and the names of the persons paid for. You can also order breakfast, lunch and dinner for additional persons (not sailing). In this case, you also have to give the names of the persons whom you are paying for and for what meals. All meals must be ordered and paid for in advance (latest 24th June) to the above-mentioned bank account.



- Assens is a city on Fyn with 6,231 inhabitants situated on the Little Belt and is located in the middle of Denmark.
- Assens is a nice little local town with local shops (restaurants, drugstore, sports gear, daily goods etc.).
- The nearest airport is Billund in Jylland (100 km / 1:15 hour in car).
- Assens Sejlklub is located near the harbour (of course) where there is also a camping site and a few houses for rent. It should also be possible to stay in an auto-camper.
